March 18, 2014, 6:30 P.M., in the assembly room of the Fulton County Office Building

Meeting Called to Order:

Jim Widman called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. Present for this meeting were council members Jim Widman, Kathy Easterday, Randy Sutton, Dave Helt, Gary Sriver, Barry Hazel, Phyl Olinger and Auditor Judy Reed.

Sheriff's Department:

Jim Widman reviewed the monthly Sheriff's reports in Sheriff Conley's absence.

Widman presented quotes on new Sheriff Department vehicles. The Council was in favor of moving forward on the purchase of the new vehicles.

Highway Department:

Rick Ranstead reported on the poor conditions of gravel and black top roads due to the weather.

Ranstead said he will get quotes for a new truck to bring to the next Council meeting so that a decision can be made on whether to move forward with the purchase.

Ranstead informed the Council that he had to purchase beet juice mix for the roads at a cost of \$18,000.

Ranstead spoke about hiring Eric Love to work 29 hours a week beginning April 1, 2014.

ADA Compliance:

Rick Ranstead reported that the ADA committee will be meeting to discuss whether polling sites have been brought completely up to ADA compliance.

There was a discussion on bringing the courthouse up to ADA compliance.

EMS:

Tim Harman presented the monthly EMS report for February.

Harmon said the EMS will be getting about a \$100,000 reimbursement from the State for 2011 and 2012 Medicaid which he would like to see used towards ambulance replacement.

Harmon informed the Council that Ambulance Billing Services is reviewing ambulance run rates to see how they compare to other counties.

County Assessor:

Judy Dancy received permission to bid out the reassessment contract.

Ordinance Establishing an Internal Service Fund for County Fuel:

ORDINANCE NO. 030314

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN

INTERNAL SERVICE FUND FOR COUNTY FUEL

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Indiana, has recently established a system for the purchase of gas and diesel fuel whereby the County contractually purchases all fuel to be stored at tanks located at the Fulton County Highway Department, and approved County departments shall obtain their fuel from these tanks at the Fulton County Highway Garage; and

WHEREAS, each department using said fuel has established their own budget for fuel usage; and

WHEREAS, the contracted vendor providing said fuel shall be invoicing Fulton County for payment of said fuel; and

WHEREAS, each County department using said fuel shall be required to pay to Fulton County the cost of this fuel use by said departments; and

WHEREAS, the Indiana State Board of Accounts requires a separate internal service fund to accurately account for the usage of said fuel by each County department; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to IC 36-1-3-2, government entities are granted the powers that they need for the effective operation of government as to local affairs; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-2-9-13 requires the Auditor to keep a separate account of appropriation made by the County fiscal body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners and Fulton County Council as follows:

Section 1: Creation

That a separate internal service fund is established for the accounting of all fuel purchased by Fulton County and used by all approved Fulton County departments.

Section 2: Operation of Internal Service Fund

The internal service fund shall pay the invoices for the purchase of all gas and diesel fuel and shall be reimbursed by all approved County departments using said fuel based upon their actual usage. <u>Section 3: Effective Date</u>

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the passing and publication as provided by law.

Ordinance Establishing an Emergency Medical Services Capital Equipment Fund:

ORDINANCE NO. 030314-A

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES CAPITAL EQUIPMENT FUND

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Indiana, has established, operates, and maintains Emergency Medical Services pursuant to IC 36-31-5, et. Seq.; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Indiana, shall be receiving reimbursement for Medicaid and Medicare service runs, specified monies from LOIT, and other specified sources of revenue; and

WHEREAS, Fulton County desires to deposit specified sources of revenue into a fund for capital equipment purchases; and

WHEREAS, IC 36-2-9-13 requires the Auditor to keep a separate account for each item of appropriation made by the County fiscal body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners and the Fulton County Council as follows:

Section 1. Creation

That a separate account is established for Fulton County Emergency Medical Service Capital Equipment Fund.

Section 2. Source of Money

That reimbursements received from Medicaid and Medicare runs, specified monies from LOIT and other specified sources of monies received by Fulton County Emergency Medical Services shall be deposited into said account created for capital equipment purchases.

Section 3. Approved Uses

That the created account shall be used for the purchase of capital equipment for the Fulton County Emergency Medical Services as approved by the Fulton County Council.

Section 4. Effective Date

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the passing and publication as provided by law.
