#### **RE: NOMINATION OF PRESIDENT FOR DRAINAGE BOARD:**

Bryan Lewis nominates Dave Sommers, and Rick Ranstead seconded it. Motion was made for Dave Sommers to be president motion passes 3-0.

#### **RE: NOMINATION FOR DRAINAGE BOARD SECRETARY:**

Rick Ranstead made a motion to nominate Lacey Holloway for drainage board secretary. Bryan Lewis seconded the motion, motion passes 3-0.

#### **RE: NOMINATION FOR VICE-PRESIDENT OF DRAINAGE BOARD:**

Bryan Lewis made motion for Rick Ranstead to be vice-president of drainage board, Dave Sommers seconded the motion. Motion passes 3-0.

#### RE: #835 MILL CREEK

Don Towne tried to push for Mill Creek to be set up on maintenance when he was still in office, that went through and then shortly after this ditch was put on hold. The mayor asked lawyer Andy Perkins to make a motion to dismiss the lawsuit. This would drop the previous request for judicial review. Trent Odell understands the county has to maintain Mill Creek, there has to have clear avenue for water to move. Mayor understands there is a lot more maintenance cost with getting the equipment in tighter areas and contractor has to dispose of the extra. Trent Odell states, "Kokomo charges almost \$100.00 per lot, so \$15.00 per lot min. with a \$5.00 per acre is a reasonable price for maintaining property." Lawyer Hollie-Pifer Shorter suggest that the drainage board have another hearing for #835 Mill Creek just to clean things up and let everyone know that the county will be collecting again. City Limits is by the treatment plant and the city owns that property, contractors could haul and burn on this property. The worst part with getting equipment in would be on Olson Road, there is a lot of clearing to do and

it is a low-lying area. It will have to be really dry or even frozen. Hearing for #835 Mill Creek was set for March  $11^{th}$  2024 @ 9:15 a.m. for maintenance. \$5.00 per acre and \$15.00 min.
