## **FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS**

## Monday, January 11, 2021

Meeting opened at 10:00 a.m. with Pledge to the Flag. Present: Commissioner Lewis, Commissioner Ranstead, Commissioner Metzger, County Attorney Holli Shorter-Pifer and Auditor Christina Sriver.

**SHERIFF** – Sheriff Sailors requested to rehire an employee who previously worked for the Highway department. Commissioner Metzger motioned to approve the rehire of Justin Melton, Commissioner Ranstead seconded; carries. Sheriff Sailors introduced the maintenance technician for the new jail.

**COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS GRANT** – The juvenile community corrections grant for fiscal year 21-22 was approved.

**AREA PLAN/INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH ROCHESTER CITY FOR ADMINITSTRATION OF BUILDING CODE AND SIDEWALD CODE** – Commissioner Ranstead motioned for approval, Commissioner Metzger seconded; carries.

**TOURISM ORDINANCE AMENDEMNT –** Commissioner Lewis read the proposed ordinance amendment aloud:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 121916 ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION TO PROMOTE THE DEVELOPMENT AND GROWTH OF THE CONVENTION VISITOR AND TOURISM INDUSTRY IN THE COUNTY OF FULTON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners did adopt an ordinance on December 19, 2016 establishing the Fulton County Tourism Commission (the "Commission"); and

WHEREAS, the terms of board members are limited to two (2) two (2)-year terms and may be reappointed after a one (1) year sabbatical; and

WHEREAS, the term limit is causing the Commission hardship in finding replacement board members.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the term limitations of two (2) two (2)-year terms shall hereby be lifted and there shall be no term limit for the members of the board and may be reappointed to unlimited two (2)-year terms.

Commissioner Ranstead motioned to suspend the rules and perform the second reading by title only, Commissioner Metzger seconded; carries. Commissioner Ranstead motioned to waive the rules and perform the third reading, Commissioner Metzger seconded; carries. Commissioner Metzger motioned to approve, Commissioner Ranstead seconded; carries.

**TOURISM BOARD APPOINTMENTS** - Commissioner Metzger motioned to approve Theresa Ogle, Melinda Clinger, and Stacey Heckathorn each for a two-year term, Commissioner Ranstead seconded; carries.

**NYONA SOUTH MUD LAKE CONSERVANCY DISTRICT PETITION TO FILL VACANIES** – A petition was proposed to Commissioners to fill vacancies on the Nyona/South Mud Lake Conservancy District. There

are currently three vacancies causing an inability to have a quorum of the directors and conduct an annual meeting. Andy Perkins prepared the petition as attorney of the Conservancy to have the Commissioners appoint the remaining term of each member who has resigned. This will be discussed further at the next meeting.

## RESOLUTION EXTENDING COVID-19 LEAVE BENEFIT

WHEREAS, on June 15<sup>th</sup>, Fulton County Board of Commissioners issued Resolution 05182020: Personnel Policies Related to Public Health Emergency Declaration for Coronavirus Disease 2019 Outbreak and due to the passage of the federal Families First Corona Response Act (FFCRA) concerning COVID-19 related to sick leave and expanded family and medical leave; and

WHEREAS, FFCRA leave benefits remained in effect through December 31, 2020. Pursuant to federal legislation adopted December 27, 2020, such benefits may be extended at the employer's election through March 31, 2021; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby elect to extend the leave benefits and will provide paid COVID-19 leave benefits to eligible employees as follows:

1. For leave taken while FFCRA remains in effect (currently through March 31, 2021) COVID-19 leave benefits shall be provided in a manner consistent with the requirements of FFCRA. In particular, eligible employees who did not exhaust such leave benefits prior to December 31,

2020, may use the remainder of said benefits, if any and if otherwise eligible, prior to March 31, 2021.

2. Paid time off for COVID-19 must be accompanied with a doctor's note or letter from Fulton County Department of Health.
