Meeting Called to Order at 8:00 a.m. with Pledge to the Flag. Present: Phyl Olinger, Ron Dittman, Steve Fishburn, Lorie Hurst, Chayse Thomspon, Pete Karas and Auditor Christina Sriver. Not present: Randy Gundrum.

2024 BUDGET DISCUSSION (HEALTH INSURANCE) - Chief Operating Officer Brad Rogers explained a primary care clinic that would cost the county \$35 per member per month. The clinic would allow for all covered members to see a primary care physician at possibly no cost to the employee depending on how the county chooses to structure the cost. This could be combined with the wellness program for savings of \$8 per month for both services. The cost of the program can be paid for with the health insurance fund and the objective is to save money on claims overall. A second service Woodlawn offers is for work-related injuries as Woodlawn now has an occupational health clinic to service these types of injuries.

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS – Lorie motioned to approve, Ron seconded; carries 6-0.
