


Meeting Called to Order at 3:00 p.m. Present: Bryan Lewis, Rick Ranstead, David Sommers, County Attorney Holli Shorter-Pifer and Deputy Auditor Christina Haughs.

**HIGHWAY** – John Geier presented permit 24-6, a request from Justin Pearson for a driveway entrance 1100 feet west of CR 500 E on 400 S. Commissioner Ranstead motioned to approve, Commissioner Sommers seconded; carries 3-0.

**CREDIT MONITORING** – Holli Shorter-Pifer stated that there was no security breach by publishing (the last four of the social security numbers). It is not illegal to produce or publish the last four numbers of someone’s social security, what happened was not wrong, it is allowed. You cannot publish the whole social security number unless the county has a specific resolution that indicates those numbers are not to be posted and we do not have one at this point. The last four digits (PI) are not considered personal information. Commissioner Lewis stated that Commissioner Ranstead and Sommers spoke with the Attorney General and were told that it is not illegal so there is no recourse. Commissioners are offering a credit monitoring service through the county’s property and casualty insurance provider. Commissioner Sommers motioned move ahead with a credit monitoring plan for county employees up to \$10,000, Commissioner Ranstead seconded; carries 3-0.

**RECESS** – Commissioner Ranstead motioned to recess at 3:51 p.m., seconded by Commissioner Sommers; carries 3-0.
