Meeting Called to Order at 5:00 p.m. with Pledge to the Flag. Present: Ron Dittman, Phyl Olinger, Steve Fishburn, Lorie Hurst, Randy Gundrum, Chayse Thompson, Pete Karas. and Auditor Christina Sriver.

Highway-John updates council on highway department activities. Community Crossing project started today out in Aubbeenaubbee Township. John talks about the two additional appropriations he has submitted for council's approval tonight. John asks council about insulating the maintenance building out at the highway department while they are putting metal siding on the building. Randy Gundrum motions to approve the insulation in the highway department maintenance building, Chayse Thompson seconds; carries 7-0. John informs council that the salt building's roof located in Kewanna will not last till next year and asks council approval to have that roof replaced. Steve Fishburn motions to approve replace the roof on the salt building roof in Kewanna with money out of the Cumulative Capital Development Fund, Lori Hurst seconds; carries 7-0.

E911-Brittany Thompson was introduced as the new E911 Director. She officially starts on September 9th, 2024. Newest dispatcher completed EMD training. There are several applications waiting for review by Brittany for the open dispatcher position.

EMA-Dawn informs council that her Everbridge contract is valid thru next year and she will reevaluate next year to see if she wants to continue using their services.

Amy Roe- Informs council on the temporary plan for an emergency heating/cooling shelter for community members in need. Also informs council that Rochester now has a part-time Domestic Violence Navigator that will be located at Fulton County Recovery Café every other week.

Coroner-Jeri updates council with a total of 98 deaths in Fulton County, 52 Females and 46 Males. Death rate in the county is down. Tomorrow is lunch and learn with LPC at the Kewanna Fire Department.
